

Resource Map

Living the life of Jesus today is about recognising and responding to God's presence in every aspect of our lives. This means that life as a Jesus disciple has lots of elements and crossover points to it. We have our own **personal walk** with Jesus, our **walk with a few** who are close to us and **our walk with many** in the wider Church and in the world. It is also important to be aware of the ways in which each of these elements feed into each other, as illustrated in the Venn diagram below.

This resource map aims to help you find resources which will be helpful to you and your church in every area of your walk with Jesus.

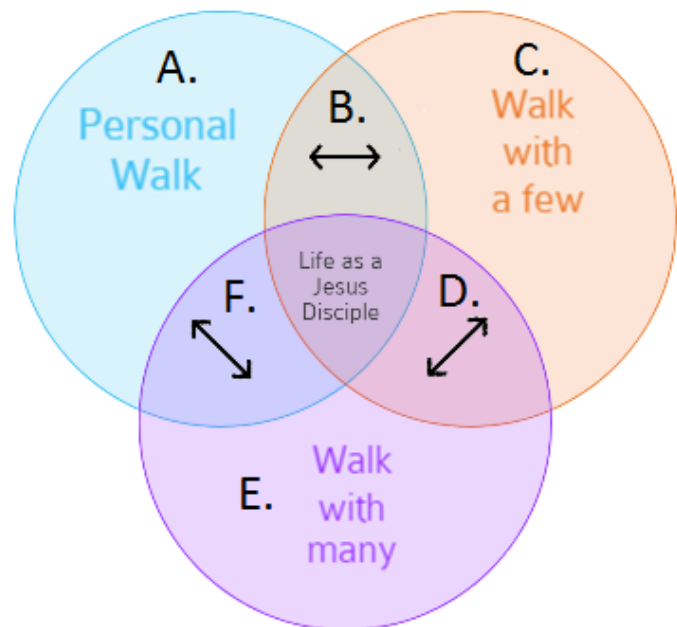

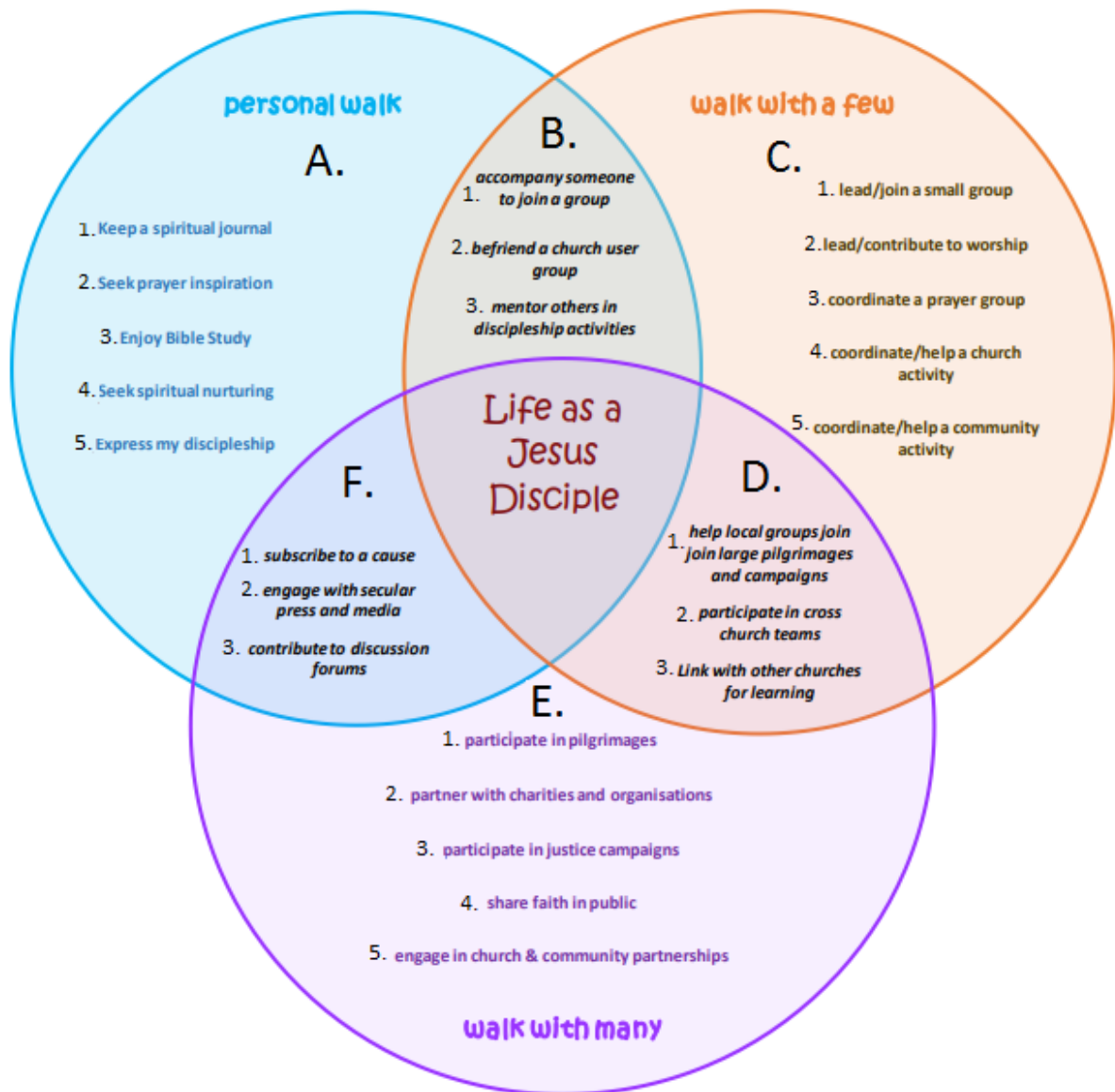
Or you can use the Venn references given alongside each resource to browse resources according to their significance for different elements and activities within the discipleship journey and explore how these connect together.

Browsing resources using the Venn diagram



Above is a more detailed version of the Venn diagram from page one, giving examples of some key activities related to each of the elements of our discipleship journey (personal walk, walk with a few, walk with many), as well as the points where these different elements crossover.

Many of the resources included in the resource map are relevant to more than one of the activities mentioned in the Venn diagram. As such, each resource included in this resource map has Venn references noted beside them, made up of letters and numbers corresponding to the elements and activities in the Venn diagram. For example, 'keep a spiritual journal' has Venn reference A1, 'participate in cross-church teams' has Venn reference D2 and so on.

You can type these Venn references into your PDF viewer's search facility to find resources which are relevant for each element and activity, regardless of what theme they are filed under. For example, if you wanted to find resources relevant to linking with other churches for learning, you would type D3 into your search facility. This would help you to find resources which might be filed under different themes, but are still relevant to the activity you're searching for.
