Dip a piece of string into some PVA glue, wipe off any excess with your fingers (this is fun to pull off your fingers when it dries!) and place it in a circle on a piece of baking paper/greaseproof paper. Make sure the ends of the string meet. Lay a length of cotton thread across the circle and form a loop at the top. Now pour some PVA glue in the centre of the circle and spread it out to touch the edges. Put some drops of blue and of green paint on and swirl them into the glue with a cocktail stick or cotton bud. Leave to dry – this may take several days – then peel your 'earth' off the paper and find somewhere to hang it where it can catch the sunlight.
