The Bible means different things to different people at different times in their lives. It's a whole collection of books written by lots of different people but we find God all through it. And we can find God in other books we read too, even story books, and in things other people tell us.

Let's make a bookmark this week to use in any book we're reading – a book of Bible stories or a different book – to help us wonder "Where is God in this story?" You need card, sticky backed plastic or clear tape, bits of coloured paper (maybe from a hole punch) or eco glitter, ribbon. Fold the card in half and cut two rectangles out of the two halves. Tape some sticky backed plastic or tape, sticky side up, over the back of one of the rectangles. Sprinkle glitter or tiny pieces of coloured paper over it. Then cover it with more sticky paper or tape, sticky side down. Fold the card shut and glue in place around the edges. Make a hole in the bottom and thread some ribbon through. Decorate to help you remember to look for God in all you read.
