Play Patience (also known as Solitaire)

Using a deck of cards, lay out seven columns as such:

- First column: one card (face up)
- Second: two cards (top one face up)
- Third: three cards (top one face up)
- ...and so on until seven columns

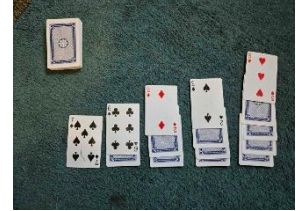
The remaining cards form a draw pile. Leave space for four "foundation" piles (one for each suit).

Move all cards to the foundation piles, building each suit from: Ace → King (same suit, in order).

You can move cards between columns if they are in descending order (King → Ace) – but they must alternate colours (red/black).

For example: You can place a red 6 on a black 7.

If you remove a face-up card and reveal a face-down one, flip it over. You win when all cards are moved to the foundation piles.

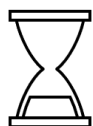

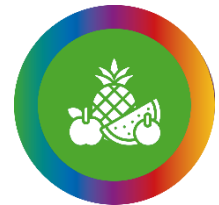
