November 1st, the day after Hallowe'en, is All Saints (or All Hallows) day. Hallow means a holy or saintly person. Our Bible passage describes a dream of all the saints gathering in heaven. What an amazing sight! We may not feel very saint-like but, if we love Jesus and try to follow his example, we are saints in the making!

Church bells often ring for All Saints Day. Why not make a bell. You'll need a yogurt pot or empty (clean) tin with the lid removed or paper cup, a pipe cleaner, and a jingle bell or a wooden bead. Make a hole in the top of the pot/tin/cup. Fasten the jingle bell or bead onto the end of a pipe cleaner and feed the other end through the hole, securing on each side of the hole by twisting. You could tape the pipe cleaner to a lolly stick as a handle. Now ring your bell! You could decorate it too.
