Here is a recipe for a friendship cake. It makes one big cake for you and your family to eat and four smaller cake mixes to give away to your friends. It takes several days to make. https://www.netmums.com/recipes/herman-friendshipcake/

Or why not use some air-drying clay or salt dough to make friendship necklaces. Roll out your dough or clay and cut out a circle or a heart shape. Using a knife, cut the shape in half with a zigzag line to create two pieces that can join together like a jigsaw. On each half write the letters BFF (best friend forever!). Use a pencil to make a hole at the top of each piece where you can thread a piece of string or cord through to make the necklace. Once the necklace is dry (clay) or cooked (salt dough), you might choose to paint or varnish each piece. Then you and your friend can wear one half each.


