CLR receives new advice for streamlining structures

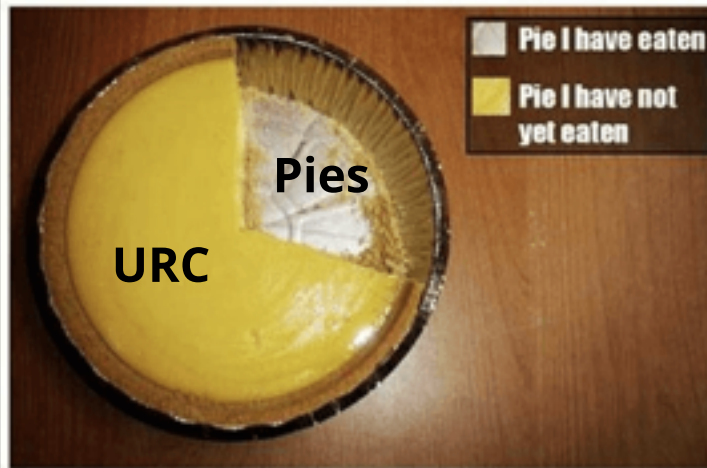
