Every month, URC Children's and Youth Work celebrates an individual who is using their God-given skills, time and talents to good effect within their church, their community, their Synod or more widely. In memory of the Revd Robert Lundie (1824-1895), we invite everyone to nominate a child or young person aged under 26.

All nominees receive a certificate (and a copy for their church), and the monthly awardee receives a chocolate medal and £100 to spend however they wish to benefit children and young people.

Since 2020, over 40 awards have been made to amazing children and young people for a huge variety of things. The youngest awardees included Noah, Eveline and Cleo, aged 4-5, for leading worship, helping at church and inspiring others. Three sets of siblings have joint awards for letterwriting, music, and raising funds for the homeless. The oldest awardees to date are Emily and Joshua, 24, for supporting overseas mission and online worship respectively. The furthest flung impact overseas so far is the Sanyu Babies Home in Kampala, Uganda, and Henry's lamp appreciation society, buying street lighting for an African village.

The Revd Robert Henry Lundie was born in Kelso, Scotland, in 1824 and at the age of 19 was called to be the minister of St Andrew's Presbyterian Church in Birkenhead. He was very active in promoting schools and Sunday schools, and worked to improve social conditions. He was Moderator of General Synod twice and later moved to Liverpool to set up a new congregation. The people of Liverpool set up a trust fund in his memory, which the URC now use to highlight the amazing things that children and young people do as disciples of Jesus, which often go unnoticed or uncelebrated.
