6 Synod Moderators' Report

The Moderator invited the Revd Jamie Kissack, Moderator, Yorkshire Synod, to introduce the Synod Moderators' Report. Mr Kissack invited the four most recently appointed Synod Moderators, the Revd Kim Plumpton, the Revd Dr Michael Hopkins, the Revd David Salisbury and the Revd Lindsey Sanderson to reflect with Assembly on the concept of God's calling.

Mr Kissack invited members of Assembly to discuss various aspects of vocation amongst themselves.

Session Two

8 Ministries

The Moderator, the Revd Professor David Thompson, took the chair, and invited the Revd Mary Thomas, Convenor, Ministries Committee, to introduce paper H3 *Process for Reconfiguring Pastorates and Scopings.*

The Revd Nicola Furley-Smith, Secretary for Ministries, answered various questions from members of Assembly. In response to questions from those concerned about the material and pastoral care of ministers caught up in a rescoping process, Ms Furley-Smith assured that pastoral care was at the heart of the policy. She pointed out that the standard practice is financial support and housing is for 6 months but that the policy noted that the Synod Moderator can ask for stipend support from the Pastoral Reference and Welfare Committee for a longer period if necessary. The General Secretary explained to Assembly the role and work of the Pastoral Reference and Welfare Committee and the care it takes in supporting ministers.

In response to discussion the Ministries Committee sought to add the following words to 9.2 "where the minister is actively engaging in the call process a further 6 months' stipend support would be granted.

The Moderator remaindered this item of business.

The Moderator invited the Revd Mary Thomas, Convenor, Ministries Committee to introduce paper H11 *Guidelines on the safer recruitment of those who lead worship in our churches.*

After discussion, the resolution was out to the vote:

General Assembly adopts the Guidelines for those who Lead Worship in our Churches.
