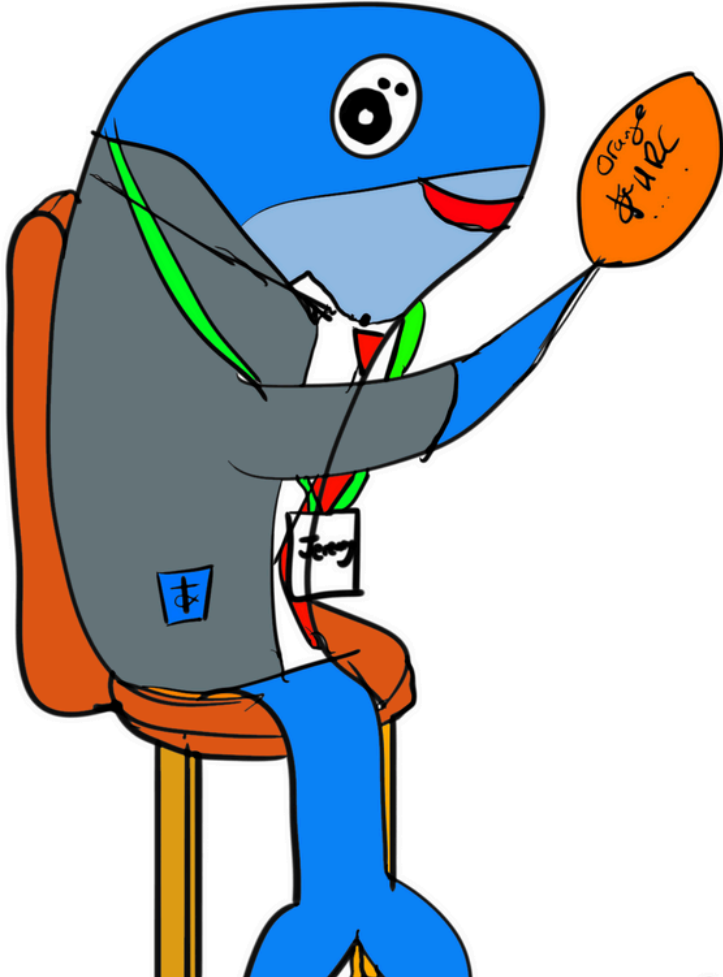

Church Police Fired After Scandal

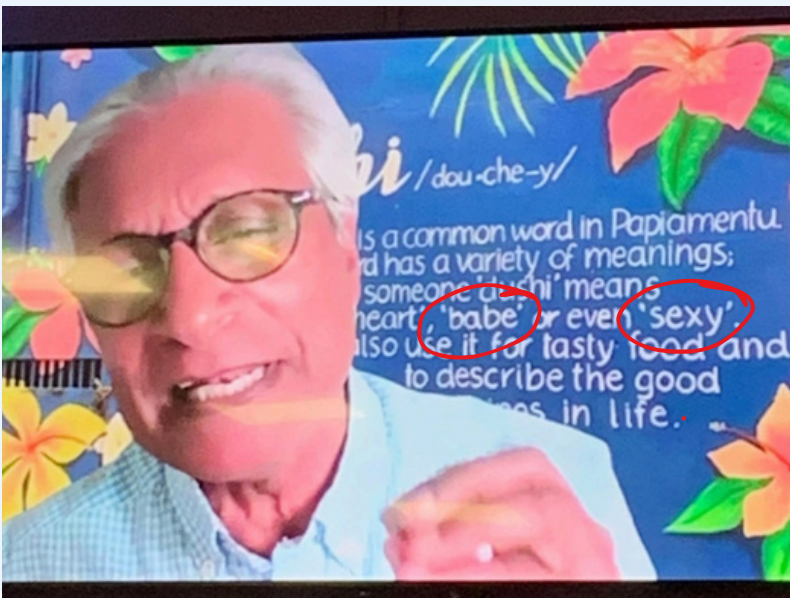

John Bradbury Confirmed a Swifty

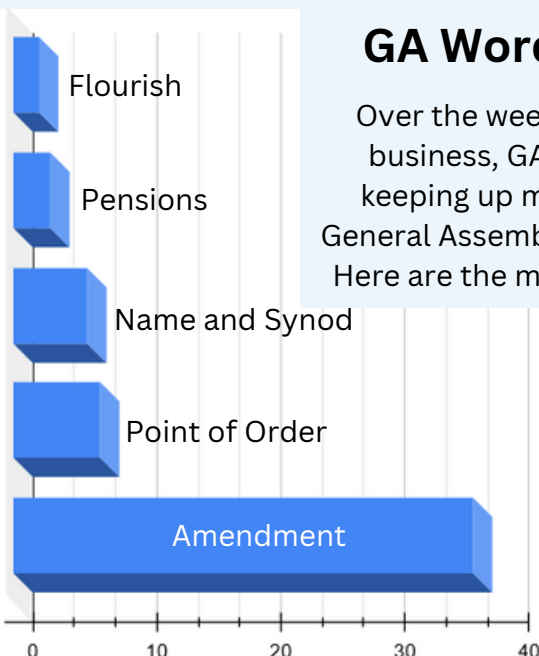
Dear John,

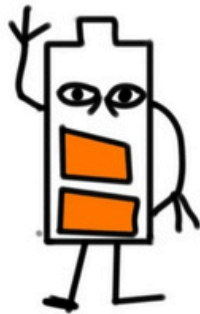
