Can olive oil create hope?" That is the question that Israeli political activist Hadas Lahav set out to answer, together with her Palestinian business partner Hanan Zoabi. Together they set up Sindyanna in 1996, a start-up aiming to build a sustainable income for Israeli and Palestinian women.

In 2015 they expanded their product lines to include a variety of olive oil, nut pastes, honey, carob syrup, olive oil soaps, and the much-prized za'atar spice. Sindyanna also opened a visitors' centre in Kafr Kana in the Galilee, where its warehouse is now based. It was one of the most memorable stops for the 2019 URC educational trip to the Holy Land. Lahav says, "Faced with the chaos and violence that we have experienced over the past year, Sindyanna is striving to continue spreading our message of equality and co-existence. We are happy to report that our sales have grown both internationally and in the local market with record breaking results... [We are] all united in the hope that we can make an impact and set an example for a better future for Palestinians and Israelis."
