The Milton Mount Foundation exists to help fund education, primarily by making grants towards school fees using funds invested from the sale of the buildings of a now closed school, and also by offering grants towards university education.

This is a voluntary but deeply rewarding role that helps shape how the Foundation supports students across the UK.

Available Volunteer Roles:

URC Representative Trustee on the Milton Mount Foundation Board

Purpose: To contribute to the strategic and practical decision-making of a longestablished educational charity serving ministers' families within the URC and Congregational traditions.

Responsibilities:

- Attend two Board meetings per year:
 - July (in person, London, with lunch and reimbursed travel)
 - November (via Zoom)
- Consider and approve bursary and grant applications
- Oversee fund investments and financial management
- Engage with Foundation administration through occasional email correspondence

Requirements:

- Must be a member of the United Reformed Church
- Willing to serve a term of four years (as set by the URC)
- Interest in education, charity governance, or church life is desirable
- Must be under the age of 80 throughout the duration of the term
