Take the top corners (left and right) and fold them in again:

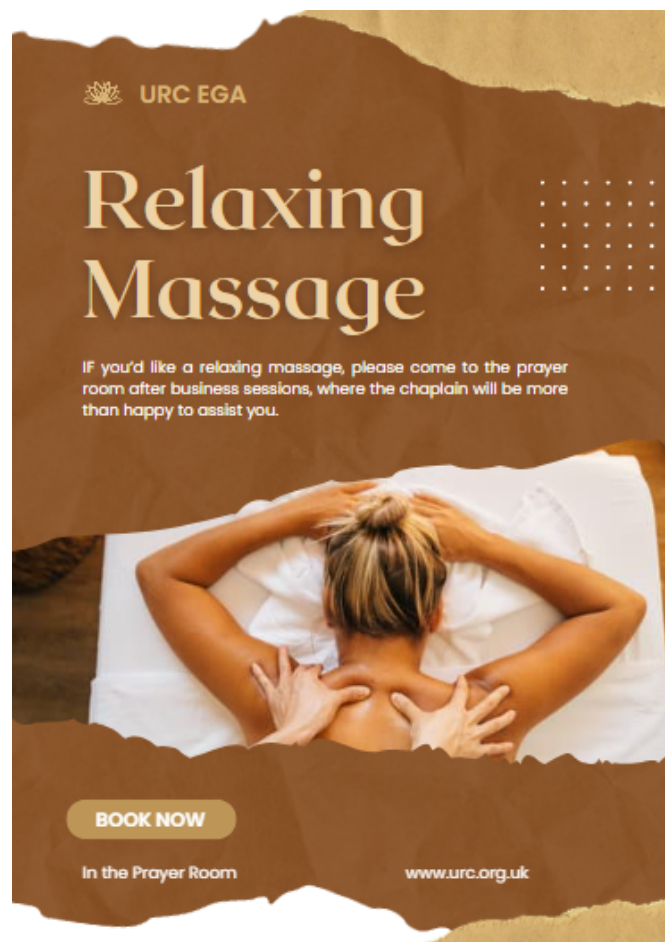
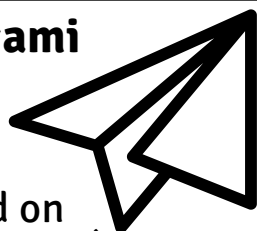
Fold the whole plane in half along the original crease, so the folded flaps are on the outside.

The nose should be at the front, and the spine/crease at the top.

From the top edge (the spine), fold one side down to make a wing.

How to throw it:

- Hold the plane under the body, just behind the nose.
- Throw it smoothly and level, not too hard. Avoid Officers of the General Assembly and Synod Moderators.
- Slight angle upward (just a little) for a longer glide.
