With support from Commitment for Life, Chipo received training in leatherwork. She also received training in leadership and business skills. This gave her renewed confidence as well as a diversified income.

Mornings are busy for Chipo. She helps her daughter, Perfect, get ready for school that is situated a few miles down a dusty road.

“When I made some sandals for my husband, school shoes for my daughter, and a handbag for my mother, I felt so happy,” said Chipo. “I saw this goat and bought it with money from my leatherwork. I am happy that it is me who made the shoes which my daughter puts on.”

### Meet the Changemakers

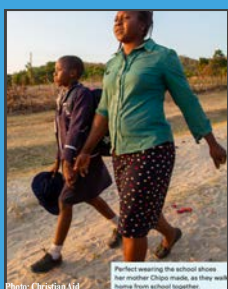
