Feature Story - Climate change affects every part of Bangladesh

‘This is their hope...’

In 2025, Peter Musgrave (Vine URC, Ilford) visited the banks of the River Jamuna. ‘I always thought climate change happened on the coast of Bangladesh, but this visit showed me that it is in fact happening much further inland.’

The Jamuna River is huge and is continuously eroding, removing large slices of land on one side and then depositing the silt further downstream. Gosaibari town is 5 km from the Jamuna River. But river erosion has destroyed

Nickil and Rani’s home four times already.

‘Nickil and Rani are holding a seedling in their hands,’ says Peter. ‘This is their hope. They keep some for themselves while they sell others in the bazaar.’ Nickel and Rani run a demonstration plot where local people can learn and copy vegetable gardening suited to climate adaptation.
